FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend sections 60-6,109 and 60-6,133, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to obligations of drivers; and to repeal the original sections. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 7 avoid colliding with any pedestrian upon any roadway and shall give
- 8 an audible signal when necessary and shall exercise proper precaution
- 9 upon observing any child or obviously confused or incapacitated
- 10 person upon a roadway.

- 13 60-6,133 Except when overtaking and passing on the right
- 14 is permitted, the following rules shall govern the overtaking and
- 15 passing of vehicles proceeding in the same direction:
- 16 (1) The driver of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle
- 17 proceeding in the same direction shall first give a visible signal of
- 18 his or her intention and shall pass to the left of the other vehicle
- 19 at a safe distance and shall not again drive to the right side of the
- 20 roadway until safely clear of the overtaken vehicle; and
- 21 (2) The driver of an overtaken vehicle shall give way to
- 22 the right in favor of the overtaking vehicle and shall not increase
- 23 the speed of his or her vehicle until completely passed by the

- 1 electric personal assistive mobility device proceeding in the same
- 2 <u>direction shall exercise due care, which shall include, but not be</u>
- 3 <u>limited to, leaving a safe distance of no less than three feet</u>
- 4 clearance, when applicable, when passing a bicycle or electric
- 5 personal assistive mobility device and shall maintain such clearance
- 6 <u>until safely past the overtaken bicycle or electric personal</u>
- 7 <u>assistive mobility device.</u>
