## A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-4,182 and
60-6,256, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
penalties relating to unlawful obstruction or
interference of the view of an operator of a motor
vehicle; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-4,182, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 60-4,182 In order to prevent and eliminate successive
- 4 traffic violations, there is hereby provided a point system dealing
- 5 with traffic violations as disclosed by the files of the director.
- 6 The following point system shall be adopted:
- 7 (1) Conviction of motor vehicle homicide 12 points;
- 8 (2) Third offense drunken driving in violation of any
- 9 city or village ordinance or of section 60-6,196, as disclosed by the
- 10 records of the director, regardless of whether the trial court found
- 11 the same to be a third offense 12 points;
- 12 (3) Failure to stop and render aid as required under
- 13 section 60-697 in the event of involvement in a motor vehicle
- 14 accident resulting in the death or personal injury of another 6
- 15 points;
- 16 (4) Failure to stop and report as required under section
- 17 60-696 or any city or village ordinance in the event of a motor
- 18 vehicle accident resulting in property damage 6 points;
- 19 (5) Driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of
- 20 alcoholic liquor or any drug or when such person has a concentration
- 21 of eight-hundredths of one gram or more by weight of alcohol per one
- 22 hundred milliliters of his or her blood or per two hundred ten liters
- 23 of his or her breath in violation of any city or village ordinance or
- 24 of section 60-6,196 6 points;
- 25 (6) Willful reckless driving in violation of any city or

- 1 village ordinance or of section 60-6,214 or 60-6,217 6 points;
- 2 (7) Careless driving in violation of any city or village
- 3 ordinance or of section 60-6,212 4 points;
- 4 (8) Negligent driving in violation of any city or village
- 5 ordinance 3 points;
- 6 (9) Reckless driving in violation of any city or village
- 7 ordinance or of section 60-6,213 5 points;
- 8 (10) Speeding in violation of any city or village
- 9 ordinance or any of sections 60-6,185 to 60-6,190 and 60-6,313:
- 10 (a) Not more than five miles per hour over the speed
- 11 limit 1 point;
- 12 (b) More than five miles per hour but not more than ten
- 13 miles per hour over the speed limit 2 points;
- 14 (c) More than ten miles per hour but not more than
- 15 thirty-five miles per hour over the speed limit 3 points, except
- 16 that one point shall be assessed upon conviction of exceeding by not
- 17 more than ten miles per hour, two points shall be assessed upon
- 18 conviction of exceeding by more than ten miles per hour but not more
- 19 than fifteen miles per hour, and three points shall be assessed upon
- 20 conviction of exceeding by more than fifteen miles per hour but not
- 21 more than thirty-five miles per hour the speed limits provided for in
- 22 subdivision (1)(e), (f), (g), or (h) of section 60-6,186; and
- 23 (d) More than thirty-five miles per hour over the speed
- 24 limit 4 points;
- 25 (11) Failure to yield to a pedestrian not resulting in

- bodily injury to a pedestrian 2 points;
- 2 (12) Failure to yield to a pedestrian resulting in bodily
- 3 injury to a pedestrian 4 points;
- 4 (13) Using a handheld wireless communication device in
- 5 violation of section 60-6,179.01 3 points; and
- 6 (14) Unlawful obstruction or interference of the view of
- 7 an operator in violation of section 60-6,256 1 point; and
- 8  $\frac{(14)-(15)}{(15)}$  All other traffic violations involving the
- 9 operation of motor vehicles by the operator for which reports to the
- 10 Department of Motor Vehicles are required under sections 60-497.01
- 11 and 60-497.02 1 point.
- Subdivision  $\frac{(14)}{(15)}$  of this section does not include
- 13 violations involving an occupant protection system pursuant to
- 14 section 60-6,270, parking violations, violations for operating a
- 15 motor vehicle without a valid operator's license in the operator's
- 16 possession, muffler violations, overwidth, overheight, or overlength
- 17 violations, motorcycle or moped protective helmet violations, or
- 18 overloading of trucks.
- 19 All such points shall be assessed against the driving
- 20 record of the operator as of the date of the violation for which
- 21 conviction was had. Points may be reduced by the department under
- 22 section 60-4,188.
- In all cases, the forfeiture of bail not vacated shall be
- 24 regarded as equivalent to the conviction of the offense with which
- 25 the operator was charged.

1 The point system shall not apply to persons convicted of

- 2 traffic violations committed while operating a bicycle or an electric
- 3 personal assistive mobility device as defined in section 60-618.02.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 60-6,256, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 60-6,256 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 7 operate a motor vehicle with any object placed or hung in or upon
- 8 such the motor vehicle, except required or permitted equipment of the
- 9 motor vehicle, in such a manner as to significantly and materially
- 10 obstruct or interfere with the view of the operator through the
- 11 windshield or to prevent the operator from having a clear and full
- 12 view of the road and condition of traffic behind such the motor
- 13 vehicle. Any sticker or identification authorized or required by the
- 14 federal government or any agency thereof or the State of Nebraska or
- 15 any political subdivision thereof may be placed upon the windshield
- 16 of the motor vehicle without violating the provisions of this
- 17 section. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
- 18 guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.
- 19 (2) Enforcement of this section by state or local law
- 20 enforcement agencies shall be accomplished only as a secondary action
- 21 when a driver of a motor vehicle has been cited or charged with a
- 22 traffic violation or some other offense.
- 23 (3) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a
- 24 traffic infraction. Any person who is found guilty of a traffic
- 25 <u>infraction under this section shall be assessed points on his or her</u>

- 2 <u>shall be fined:</u>
- 3 <u>(a) Fifty dollars for the first offense;</u>
- 4 (b) One hundred dollars for a second offense; and
- 5 (c) One hundred fifty dollars for a third and subsequent
- 6 <u>offense.</u>
- 7 Sec. 3. Original sections 60-4,182 and 60-6,256, Reissue
- 8 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
