A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend
2 section 53-179, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 change provisions relating to sale hours; and to repeal
4 the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-179, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 53-179 (1) No alcoholic liquor, including beer, shall be
4 sold at retail or dispensed on any day between the hours of 1 a.m.
5 and 6 a.m., except that the local governing body of any city or
6 village with respect to area inside the corporate limits of such city
7 or village, or the county board with respect to area outside the
8 corporate limits of any city or village, may by ordinance or
9 resolution (a) require closing prior to 1 a.m. on any day or (b) if
10 adopted by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of such local
11 governing body or county board, permit retail sale or dispensing of
12 alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, excluding sales for
13 consumption off the premises, later than 1 a.m. and prior to 2 a.m.
14 on any day.

15 (2) Except as provided for and allowed by ordinance of a
16 local governing body applicable to area inside the corporate limits
17 of a city or village or by resolution of a county board applicable to
18 area inside such county and outside the corporate limits of any city
19 or village, no alcoholic liquor, including beer, shall be sold at
20 retail or dispensed between the hours of 6 a.m. Sunday and 1 a.m.
21 Monday. ~~No ordinance or resolution allowed by this subsection shall~~
22 ~~permit alcoholic liquor, other than beer and wine, to be sold at~~
23 ~~retail or dispensed between the hours of 6 a.m. Sunday and 12 noon~~
24 ~~Sunday.~~ This subsection shall not apply after 12 noon on Sunday to a
25 licensee which is a nonprofit corporation and the holder of a Class C

1 license or a Class I license.

2 (3) It shall be unlawful on property licensed to sell
3 alcoholic liquor at retail to allow alcoholic liquor in open
4 containers to remain or be in possession or control of any person for
5 purposes of consumption between the hours of fifteen minutes after
6 the closing hour applicable to the licensed premises and 6 a.m. on
7 any day.

8 (4) Nothing in this section shall prohibit licensed
9 premises from being open for other business on days and hours during
10 which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by
11 this section.

12 Sec. 2. Original section 53-179, Reissue Revised Statutes
13 of Nebraska, is repealed.
