A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to banking and finance; to amend section 2 8-101.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2010; 3 to require return to the payee of insufficient funds checks, drafts, assignments of funds, and similar signed 4 orders as prescribed; to provide powers and duties for 5 the Department of Banking and Finance; to provide for a 6 civil penalty; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the 7 8 original section.

- 3 8-101.01 Sections 8-101 to 8-1,140 <u>and section 2 of this</u>
- 4 <u>act</u>shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Banking Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) When a check, draft, assignment of funds, or
- 6 similar signed order is deposited in a financial institution by the
- 7 payee of the instrument and subsequently refused by the financial
- 8 institution of the drawer of the instrument for any reason, the
- 9 <u>financial institutions of the drawer and payee shall cause the</u>
- 10 instrument to be returned to the payee. The instrument shall be
- 11 returned in its entirety and in such a condition that all information
- on the instrument identifying the drawer is legible.
- 13 (2) This section shall be enforced by the Department of
- 14 Banking and Finance. Any financial institution violating this section
- 15 shall be subject to a civil penalty of five hundred dollars.
