- FOR AN ACT relating to the Uniform Credentialing Act; to amend section 38-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to fees; and to repeal the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 38-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 38-155 (1) The department, with the recommendation of the
- 4 appropriate board if applicable, or the Water Well Standards and
- 5 Contractors' Licensing Board as provided in section 38-151, shall
- 6 adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to establish and collect
- 7 the fees for the following credentials:
- 8 (a) Initial credentials, which include, but are not
- 9 limited to:
- 10 (i) Licensure, certification, or registration;
- 11 (ii) Add-on or specialty credentials;
- 12 (iii) Temporary, provisional, or training credentials;
- 13 and
- 14 (iv) Supervisory or collaborative relationship
- 15 credentials;
- 16 (b) Applications to renew licenses, certifications, and
- 17 registrations;
- 18 (c) Approval of continuing education courses and other
- 19 methods of continuing competency; and
- 20 (d) Inspections and reinspections.
- 21 (2) When a credential will expire within one hundred
- 22 eighty days after its initial issuance date and the initial
- 23 credentialing fee is twenty-five dollars or more, the department
- 24 shall collect twenty-five dollars or one-fourth of the initial
- 25 credentialing fee, whichever is greater, for the initial credential,

- 1 and the or its reinstatement date, the department shall collect one-
- 2 fourth of the initial credentialing fee or the renewal fee, except
- 3 that if the initial credentialing fee or the renewal fee is twenty-
- 4 five dollars or less, the department shall collect twenty-five
- 5 <u>dollars. The initial or reinstated</u> credential shall be valid until
- 6 the next subsequent renewal date.
