A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the State Electrical Act; to amend section
2 81-2124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to inspections; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-2124, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-2124 (1) All new electrical installations for
4 commercial or industrial applications, including installations both
5 inside and outside of the buildings and installations for grain
6 handling and irrigation equipment regardless of location, and for
7 public-use buildings and facilities and any installation at the
8 request of the owner shall be subject to the inspection and
9 enforcement provisions of the State Electrical Act.

10 (2) All new electrical installations for residential
11 applications in excess of single-family residential applications
12 shall be subject to the inspection and enforcement provisions of the
13 act.

14 (3) All new electrical installations for single-family
15 residential applications requiring new electrical service equipment
16 shall be subject to the inspection and enforcement provisions of the
17 act.

18 (4) Existing electrical installations observed during
19 inspection which constitute an electrical hazard shall be subject to
20 the act. Existing installations shall not be deemed to constitute an
21 electrical hazard if the wiring when originally installed was
22 installed in accordance with the electrical code in force at the time
23 of installation and has been maintained in that condition.
