A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to state funds; to amend section 84-1616, Reissue
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; section 66-1345.04, Revised
3 Statutes Supplement, 2011; and Laws 2011, LB378, section
4 14; to provide for a transfer; to change provisions
5 relating to certain transfers; to change the use of a
6 fund; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an
7 emergency.
8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$99,166.37
2 from the State Insurance Fund to the Roads Operations Cash Fund on
3 the effective date of this bill or as soon thereafter as
4 administratively possible.

5 Sec. 2. Laws 2011, LB378, section 14, is amended to read:

6 Sec. 14. The State Treasurer shall transfer up to
7 \$3,800,000 from the General Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive
8 Cash Fund on or before ~~June 30,~~ December 31, 2012, on such ~~date~~ dates
9 and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the
10 budget division of the Department of Administrative Services,
11 pursuant to subdivision (2)(1) of section 66-1345.04.

12 Sec. 3. Section 66-1345.04, Revised Statutes Supplement,
13 2011, is amended to read:

14 66-1345.04 (1) The State Treasurer shall transfer from
15 the General Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund, on or
16 before the end of each of fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97,
17 \$8,000,000 per fiscal year.

18 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that the
19 following General Fund amounts be appropriated to the Ethanol
20 Production Incentive Cash Fund in each of the following years:

21 (a) For each of fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99,
22 \$7,000,000 per fiscal year;

23 (b) For fiscal year 1999-2000, \$6,000,000;

24 (c) For fiscal year 2000-01, \$5,000,000;

25 (d) For fiscal year 2001-02 and for each of fiscal years

1 2003-04 through 2006-07, \$1,500,000;

2 (e) For each of fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07,
3 \$2,500,000 in addition to the amount in subdivision (2)(d) of this
4 section;

5 (f) For fiscal year 2007-08, \$5,500,000;

6 (g) For each of fiscal years 2008-09 through 2011-12,
7 \$2,500,000;

8 (h) For each of fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07,
9 \$5,000,000 in addition to the other amounts in this section;

10 (i) For fiscal year 2007-08, \$15,500,000 in addition to
11 the other amounts in this section;

12 (j) For fiscal year 2009-10, \$8,250,000 in addition to
13 the other amounts in this section;

14 (k) For fiscal year 2010-11, \$3,000,000 in addition to
15 the other amounts in this section; and

16 (l) For fiscal ~~year-years~~ 2011-12 and 2012-13, amounts
17 totaling up to \$3,800,000 in addition to the other amounts in this
18 section.

19 Sec. 4. Section 84-1616, Reissue Revised Statutes of
20 Nebraska, is amended to read:

21 84-1616 The Health and Life Benefit Administration Cash
22 Fund is created. The fund shall consist of (1) payments made by
23 individuals eligible for program benefits, (2) transfers from the
24 State Employees Insurance Fund for administrative and operation
25 expenses as authorized by the Legislature, ~~and~~ (3) interest earnings

1 as authorized by the Legislature, and (4) sums that are contributed
2 as gifts, donations, grants, or bequests to provide multicultural or
3 diversity education, training, and events. The fund shall be used by
4 the personnel division of the Department of Administrative Services
5 to administer the provisions of the federal Public Health Service
6 Act, ~~and~~ for the administration of the section 125 plan, and for the
7 administration of multicultural or diversity education, training, and
8 events. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
9 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
10 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

11 Sec. 5. Original section 84-1616, Reissue Revised
12 Statutes of Nebraska, section 66-1345.04, Revised Statutes
13 Supplement, 2011, and Laws 2011, LB378, section 14, are repealed.

14 Sec. 6. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
15 when passed and approved according to law.
