LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 574

Introduced by Carlson, 38.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to monitor and review the anticipated disease traceability final rule by the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service of the United States Department of Agriculture associated with the Animal Disease Traceability Comprehensive Report and Implementation Plan. The study shall further examine any role of registered livestock brands in meeting identification requirements for livestock moving in interstate commerce, and particularly technological advancements that may enhance brand registration and inspection in meeting the disease traceability goals of the pending rule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
