**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1002 creates an exception to the long-term care bed moratorium in N.R.S. § 71-5829.04 (1)(b) for long-term care facilities developed and licensed by a political subdivision or nonprofit organization in a city of the second class or village if specific conditions are met.

The exception to the moratorium applies when all long-term care beds in a city of the second class or village were sold or transferred to a facility or facilities located outside a 25 mile radius from the city or village resulting in no long-term care beds within the corporate limits of the city of the second class or village.
