Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 1126 seeks to provide the ability for villages to square-off and extend their one mile extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) by requesting from the county to cede up to the next quarter-mile section of land extending beyond their current ETJ.

Currently, in Section 13-327, a city of the first class may request from the county to cede land to extend their ETJ beyond their current two mile ETJ, and a city of the second may do the same beyond their current one mile ETJ, pursuant to the conditions in section 13-327. LB1126 would provide similar authority to villages to provide a clearer idea of where the ETJ ends.
