## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 381, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is a part of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations.

This bill proposes three statutory changes which will result in reductions to General Fund appropriations beginning in FY 2011-12 as follows:

- 1. Eliminates membership in the Education Commission of the States, effective one year after the Governor's written withdrawal, which shall occur upon passage of this bill. Membership dues will cease in FY 2012-13.
- 2. Prohibits Educational Service Units (ESU) from serving Class IV and Class V school districts and prohibits the formation of ESUs serving only one school district effective July 1, 2011. If an ESU serves only a Class IV or Class V district, then the assets and liabilities of such ESUs shall be transferred to the respective school district. As a consequence of this legislation, ESUs 18 and 19 will be eliminated.
- 3. Removes statutory requirements that the Nebraska Department of Education employ a "student achievement coordinator."

This legislative bill has an operative date of July 1, 2011, and contains the emergency clause.
