Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 58 would require the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, in collaboration with the State Department of Education, public postsecondary education institutions, and school districts, to conduct a study regarding the need for uniform policies and practices for dual-enrollment courses and career academies in Nebraska, including transferability of dual-enrollment courses and consistency of administration of career academies. The Commission would be required to report the findings of such study and its recommendations, including recommendations for possible legislation, to the Legislature on or before December 15, 2011.
