**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 726 eliminates the statutory requirement for the DMV to send a number of notices by registered or first class mail, including notices for failure to comply, point suspensions for persons under 21 years, commercial driver license disqualifications, point revocations, and suspension for failing to maintain financial responsibility involved in a motor vehicle accident. Thousands of these notices are returned undeliverable every year.

The DMV will use regular U.S. mail to send the notices.
