LB 1061 would eliminate the requirement that members of the governing boards of community colleges be elected and replace the installation process with that of those members of the community college board being appointed by the county boards that comprise the community college area. LB 1061 also deletes references to elected members of the community college board or community college area from Nebraska statutes.
