The bill as drafted would prohibit cities in Nebraska from imposing a city occupation tax on any transaction subject to a tax under the following sections of Nebraska law. Sections 53-160, 66-489,66-489.02, 66-4140, 66-4145, 66-4146, 77-2602, or 77-4008. These are sections imposing excise taxes on alcohol, motor fuels, and tobacco products.
