Pursuant to LR 31, the Children's Behavioral Health Oversight Committee would continue until the beginning of the 2014 session in order to provide an orderly transition of its oversight to the Nebraska Children's Commission. The committee would consist of nine members of the Legislature appointed by the Executive Board as follows: (a) two members of the Appropriations Committee; (b) two members of the Health & Human Services Committee; (c) two members of the Judiciary Committee; and (d) three members of the Legislature who are not members of the above three committees. Consideration shall be given to appointing members who previously served on the committee.
