A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in
2 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 690, One
3 Hundred Third Legislature, Second Session, 2014; and to
4 declare an emergency.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$1,760 from the
2 General Fund for FY2013-14 to the Legislative Council, for Program
3 122, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 690,
4 One Hundred Third Legislature, Second Session, 2014.

5 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
6 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
7 in this section.

8 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$228,061 from
9 the General Fund and \$228,061 from federal funds for FY2014-15 and
10 (2) \$77,194 from the General Fund and \$77,194 from federal funds for
11 FY2015-16 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program
12 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 690,
13 One Hundred Third Legislature, Second Session, 2014.

14 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
15 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
16 exceed \$80,831 for FY2014-15 or \$80,831 for FY2015-16.

17 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,629,187 from
18 the General Fund and \$12,041,518 from federal funds for FY2014-15 and
19 (2) \$5,258,374 from the General Fund and \$17,840,154 from federal
20 funds for FY2015-16 to the Department of Health and Human Services,
21 for Program 348, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
22 Bill 690, One Hundred Third Legislature, Second Session, 2014.

23 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
24 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
25 in this section.

1 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
2 when passed and approved according to law.
