**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1055**

A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary education; to provide for
- 2                   tuition-free academic credits for veterans and military
- 3                   personnel as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Each public postsecondary educational  
2 institution in Nebraska shall provide for fifteen tuition-free  
3 undergraduate credit hours for each enrolled resident student who is  
4 eligible for educational benefits pursuant to the federal Post-9/11  
5 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008 or the federal Post-9/11  
6 Veterans Educational Assistance Improvements Act of 2010, as such  
7 acts existed on January 1, 2014, or other federal education benefits  
8 available to a veteran as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101, as such section  
9 existed on January 1, 2014, or a person on active duty with the armed  
10 services of the United States. Such institutions shall adopt rules,  
11 regulations, and policies to carry out this section.
