- 6 accredited school, or (3) supervisor of any special subjects or
- 7 subject in which such persons actually supervise the work of other
- 8 teachers in that subject or those subjects shall hold a Nebraska
- 9 certificate to administer.
- 10 <u>(2) The State Board of Education may waive the</u>
- 11 requirement of a Nebraska certificate to administer for a person
- 12 holding the title of superintendent of schools, at the request of a
- 13 school district's school board or board of education.
