A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to election commissioners; to amend section
2 32-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require
3 legislative approval of gubernatorial appointments; and
4 to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 32-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 32-207 The office of election commissioner shall be
4 created for each county having a population of more than one hundred
5 thousand inhabitants. The election commissioner shall be appointed by
6 the Governor subject to the approval of a majority of the members of
7 the Legislature and shall serve for a term of four years or until a
8 successor has been appointed and qualified. In the event of a
9 vacancy, the Governor shall appoint an election commissioner subject
10 to the approval of a majority of the members of the Legislature to
11 serve the unexpired portion of the term. If the Legislature is not in
12 session, any appointment shall be temporary until the next session of
13 the Legislature, at which time a majority of the members of the
14 Legislature may approve or disapprove such appointment.

15 Sec. 2. Original section 32-207, Reissue Revised Statutes
16 of Nebraska, is repealed.
