A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-101,
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to change
3 penalty provisions with respect to Class IA felonies
4 committed by persons under the age of eighteen years; and
5 to repeal the original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1356 and section 2 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.

5 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
6 penalty for any person convicted of a Class IA felony for an offense
7 committed when such person was under the age of eighteen years shall
8 be a maximum sentence of life imprisonment and a minimum sentence of
9 XXXX years imprisonment.

10 Sec. 3. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes
11 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is repealed.
