LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 564

Introduced by Schilz, 47.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to identify issues positively or negatively affecting producer welfare associated with marketing and production contracting and to examine regulatory and statutory provisions governing packer procurement of swine through marketing or production contracting under the federal Packers and Stockyards Act and in other states. The study shall further examine the extent of slaughter and marketing venues other than delivery to major packing companies, including direct marketing and consumer organized procurement, that are available to Nebraska producers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
