**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

To allow the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to build an online system for issuing trip permits to commercial drivers who are not members of the International Registration Plan or International Fuel Tax Agreement, prior to conducting business in Nebraska, valid for a period of 72 hours. Currently, the Nebraska State Patrol (NSP), as agent for the DMV, manages a paper based system where drivers purchase trip permits from vendors once they arrive in Nebraska. An online system would reduce accounting time and errors, reduce fraud, improve veracity of audits, and be accessible roadside to NSP Carrier Enforcement.
