The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB31 was introduced to establish that in the event a temporarily handicapped or disabled person is in need of a temporary handicapped parking tag, a medical professional has the option of recommending either a three or a six month period during which the handicapped or disabled person is expected to recover. The medical recommendation shall be submitted as a part of the temporary handicapped parking tag application process.

LB31 further establishes that the temporary handicapped parking permit may be renewed one time upon the submission of an application which includes medical proof of the continuing handicap or disability.

Further LB31 repeals the original sections.
