The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 351 establishes that a cognitive test be used at the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles as a screening tool to indicate cognitive impairment for those persons at and over the age of 80. A standard written test will follow if it has been determined there is cognitive impairment.

The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles may choose a cognitive test under the promulgation of rules and regulations.
