**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 356 provides that any nonpublic school which rejects an application for admission of any child with a disability shall not be eligible for participation in school-sponsored co-curricular or extracurricular activities administered or managed by an organization whose purpose is statewide administration and management of such activities.

The bill further provides an option for the nonpublic school to participate in the above-mentioned activities if such school reimburses the school district of residence of such child for its actual expenses in providing special education services for such child and provides or pays for transportation services associated with such special education services.
