The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 383 would permit the issuance of Nebraska Armed Forces Pride license plates.

Qualified applicants could select from the following: United States Army, United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, United States Air Force, Nebraska National Guard, Nebraska Air National Guard.

Alphanumeric plates and personalized message plates would be available.

Applicants would pay an annual fee of \$5 for alphanumeric plates and \$40 for personalized plates.

Applicants for alphanumeric plates may elect not to pay the fee on one set of alphanumeric plates.

Fees for alphanumeric plates would be credited to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

Fees for personalized message plates would be credited twenty-five percent of the fee to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and seventy-five percent of the fee to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.
