The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 478 would require that at least 25% of the recipients granted awards under the Access College Early Scholarship Program are enrolled in a skilled and technical sciences program. The bill defines a skilled and technical sciences program as a curriculum of instruction that includes, but is not limited to: housing and home furnishings; woods and construction; construction-electricity; construction-home maintenance; computer-assisted drafting; metals and welding; manufacturing-metalworking; manufacturing-woodworking; millwork and cabinetmaking; electronics; technology engineering education; principles of technology; technology education; transportation power; auto mechanics; automotive services; data base management; and computer applications.
