**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB699 creates an exception to Neb. Rev. St. 37-404 to allow a developmentally disabled person to obtain a hunting permit if that person obtains a license-purchase exemption certificate from the Game and Parks Commission.

LB699 also removes the separate bow hunter education program and consolidates the required hunter education program for all hunting implements--including firearms, crossbows, bow and arrows, and air guns--into one program.
