

AMENDMENTS TO LB465

Introduced by Government, Military and Veterans Affairs.

1 1. Insert the following new sections:

2 Sec. 17. Sections 64-101 to 64-119 and 64-211 to 64-215 and the
3 Uniform Recognition of Acknowledgments Act govern an electronic notary
4 public unless the provisions of such sections and act are in conflict
5 with the Electronic Notary Public Act in which case the Electronic Notary
6 Public Act controls.

7 Sec. 18. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2016.

8 2. On page 2, line 1, strike "16" and insert "17"; after line 17
9 insert the following new subsection:

10 "(6) Electronic notary solution provider means a provider of any
11 electronic notary seals or electronic signatures;"; in line 18 strike
12 "(6)" and insert "(7)"; and in line 21 strike "(7)" and insert "(8)".

13 3. On page 3, after line 6, insert the following new subsection:

14 "(2) The registration shall specify the technology the notary public
15 intends to use to perform an electronic notarial act. Such technology
16 shall be provided by an electronic notary solution provider approved by
17 the Secretary of State."; in line 7 strike "(2)" and insert "(3)"; in
18 line 9 strike "(3)" and insert "(4)"; in line 20 strike "fifty dollars";
19 and in line 21 after the period insert "The Secretary of State shall
20 establish the fee by rule and regulation in an amount sufficient to cover
21 the costs of administering the Electronic Notary Public Act, but the fee
22 shall not exceed one hundred dollars.".

23 4. On page 5, line 3, after "resigned" insert ", canceled,"; and in
24 line 9 after "revoked" insert ", canceled,".

25 5. On page 6, line 21, after the period insert "Such rules and
26 regulations shall include procedures for the approval of electronic
27 notary solution providers by the Secretary of State.".
