5 81-829.49 Each local government, school district, or educational 6 service unit shall have the power to make appropriations in the manner provided by law for making appropriations for the ordinary expenses of 7 such local government, school district, or educational service unit for 8 the payment of expenses of its city, village, county, school district, 9 educational service unit, or interjurisdictional emergency management 10 organization and in furthering the purposes of the Emergency Management 11 12 Act.

Sec. 2. Section 81-829.51, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

81-829.51 In the event of a disaster, emergency, or civil defense 15 emergency, each local government, school district, or educational service 16 unit may make emergency expenditures, enter into contracts, and incur 17 obligations for emergency management purposes regardless of existing 18 statutory limitations and requirements pertaining to appropriation, 19 20 budgeting, levies, or the manner of entering into contracts. If any such expenditure, contract, or obligation will be in excess of or in violation 21 of existing statutory limitations or requirements, then before any such 22 expenditure, contract, or obligation is undertaken it shall be approved 23 by a vote of the governing body of such local government, school 24 district, or educational service unit. The and such governing body may 25 not vote its approval unless it has secured a copy of the proclamation as 26 27 provided in section 81-829.50 from the certificate of the city, village,

county, or interjurisdictional emergency management director serving such
local government, school district, or educational service unit. For
school districts and educational service units, the proclamation shall be
secured from the county in which the school district or principal office
of the educational service unit is located that such action is necessary
in the public interest for emergency management purposes.
