Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 10 eliminates the current presidential elector system in Nebraska in which one presidential elector is chose from each congressional district and two presidential electors are chosen at large. Under this legislation, each presidential elector will cast his or her ballot for the presidential candidate who receives the highest number of votes in the state.

This will allow the presidential candidate who receives the highest number of votes in the state will receive all five electoral votes.
