LB254 would adopt the Uniform Unsworn Foreign Declarations Act. Under the act, a person outside of the United States may make a declaration under penalty of perjury in a signed record that would have the same legal effect as a sworn statement, verification, certificate or affidavit given under oath.

Explanation of amendments:

This amendment would add a conveyance of an interest in real estate and a power of attorney to the list of declarations and oaths that are excluded from the Act under Section 6 of LB254.
