## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 378 would require that a city of the first class identify on the ballot the specific type of financing being used for the purpose of purchasing and improving land for parks and recreational facilities. The bill also requires that if the city decides to change the type of financing being used, the proposal to refinance must be placed on the ballot.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 637 provides that a proposal to refinance would only have to be placed on the ballot if the type of security was being changed from revenue bonds to general obligation bonds.
