Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-165.01, issuance of printed certificates of title to motor vehicles.

Currently this section provides that a lienholder, on the behalf of the owner of the vehicle, may request the issuance of a printed certificate of title when the owner of the vehicle is relocating outside of the state.

The section is amended by adding a new subsection (2) that provides that a nonresident of this state may apply for the issuance of a Nebraska certificate of title. If there is any lien filed upon the vehicle the county treasurer shall issue the certificate of title with all liens noted. A non-resident receiving a certificate of title pursuant to this new subsection must indicate on the application that they will immediately surrender the Nebraska- issued title to the appropriate official in their state of residence and obtain a certificate of title in conformance with the laws of that state.

Note:

Section 60-144 provides that when a nonresident applies for a Nebraska motor vehicle title, the application must be filed in the county in which the purchase of the vehicle was consummated.
