Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 981 was introduced by the Business & Labor Committee at the request of the Department of Administrative Services, Risk Management Division. This bill introduces the claims against the State that are required by statute to be reviewed and approved by the Legislature.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 2405 includes additional claims that arose after the date of introduction of LB 981.

It includes a miscellaneous claim for \$261,862; three additional tort claims for \$800,000, \$185,000, and \$400,000; and two workers' compensation claims for \$115,000 and \$275,000.

It also reduces the write-off request from the Department of Health and Human Services to \$1,590,534.29; includes a write-off request from Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for \$5,246.61; and strikes the write-off request from the Lottery Division of the Department of Revenue.
