**Explanation of Estimate:** 

The proposed legislation would eliminate the need for the Governor and the Legislature to approve the acquisition of real property or structures with the proceeds of donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants ("gift") from individuals, organizations, corporations, foundations, or similar entities or from nonfederal government agencies, if the proceeds of such donations, gifts, bequests, devises, or grants ("gift") exceed two hundred fifty thousand dollars <u>provided</u> the 'gift' does not necessitate an increase in existing budget authority.

No direct fiscal impact is anticipated, however by not having to revisit projects that have already been approved through the budget process, staff time can be redirected towards other activities.
