- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Political Accountability and
- 2 Disclosure Act; to amend section 49-1499.03, Reissue Revised
- 3 Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to conflict of
- 4 interest statements; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 49-1499.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 49-1499.03 (1)(a) An official of a political subdivision designated
- 4 in section 49-1493 who would be required to take any action or make any
- 5 decision in the discharge of his or her official duties that may cause
- 6 financial benefit or detriment to him or her, a member of his or her
- 7 immediate family, or a business with which he or she is associated, which
- 8 is distinguishable from the effects of such action on the public
- 9 generally or a broad segment of the public, shall take the following
- 10 actions as soon as he or she is aware of such potential conflict or
- 11 should reasonably be aware of such potential conflict, whichever is
- 12 sooner:
- (i) Prepare a written statement describing the matter requiring
- 14 action or decision and the nature of the potential conflict; and
- 15 (ii) Deliver a copy of the statement to the commission and to the
- 16 person in charge of keeping records for the political subdivision who
- 17 shall enter the statement onto the public records of the subdivision.
- 18 (b) The official shall take such action as the commission shall
- 19 advise or prescribe to remove himself or herself from influence over the
- 20 action or decision on the matter.
- 21 (c) This subsection does not prevent such a person from making or
- 22 participating in the making of a governmental decision to the extent that
- 23 the individual's participation is legally required for the action or
- 24 decision to be made. A person acting pursuant to this subdivision shall
- 25 report the occurrence to the commission.
- 26 (2)(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3) of this
- 27 <u>section, any</u> Person holding an elective office of a city or village
- 28 not designated in section 49-1493 and any person holding an elective
- 29 office of a school district or an educational service unit who would be
- 30 required to take any action or make any decision in the discharge of his
- 31 or her official duties that may cause financial benefit or detriment to

- 1 him or her, a member of his or her immediate family, or a business with
- 2 which he or she is associated, which is distinguishable from the effects
- 3 of such action on the public generally or a broad segment of the public,
- 4 shall take the following actions as soon as he or she is aware of such
- 5 potential conflict or should reasonably be aware of such potential
- 6 conflict, whichever is sooner:
- 7 (i) Prepare a written statement describing the matter requiring
- 8 action or decision and the nature of the potential conflict;
- 9 (ii) Deliver a copy of the statement to the person in charge of
- 10 keeping records for the city, village, or school district, or educational
- 11 service unit who shall enter the statement onto the public records of the
- 12 city, village, or school district, or educational service unit; and
- 13 (iii) Abstain from participating or voting on the matter in which
- 14 the person holding elective office has a potential conflict of interest.
- 15 (b) The person holding elective office may apply to the commission
- 16 for an opinion as to whether the person has a conflict of interest.
- 17 (3) If a person holding an elective office of a school district or
- 18 <u>an educational service unit is the designated representative of the</u>
- 19 school district or educational service unit to a business and serves as a
- 20 director or officer on its board as described in section 49-1408, the
- 21 person may deliver a written statement describing the business
- 22 association to the person in charge of keeping records for the school
- 23 district or educational service unit who shall enter the statement onto
- 24 the public records of the school district or educational service unit.
- 25 The officeholder may participate and vote on any matter for which the
- 26 written statement explains any potential conflict of interest due to the
- 27 <u>business association without submitting any further written statement.</u>
- 28  $(4 \ 3)$  Matters involving an interest in a contract are governed
- 29 either by sections 49-14,102 and 49-14,103 or by sections 49-14,103.01 to
- 30 49-14,103.06. Matters involving the hiring of an immediate family member
- 31 are governed by section 49-1499.04. Matters involving nepotism or the

- 1 supervision of a family member by an official or employee in the
- 2 executive branch of state government are governed by section 49-1499.07.
- 3 Sec. 2. Original section 49-1499.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, is repealed.
