**LEGISLATIVE BILL 115**

Introduced by Scheer, 19.

Committee: Banking, Commerce and Insurance

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to social security numbers; to define a term;

2 to prohibit certain actions; and to provide exceptions.

3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:

2           (a) Social security number means a nine-digit number under section  
3 205(c)(2) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 405(c)(2), issued by the  
4 United States Social Security Administration;

5           (b) Social security number includes any number derived from the  
6 issued number; and

7           (c) Social security number does not include any number that has been  
8 encrypted.

9           (2) No person as defined in section 49-801 shall require an  
10 individual to disclose or furnish his or her social security number for  
11 any purpose in connection with any activity or refuse any service,  
12 privilege, or right to an individual because he or she refuses to  
13 disclose or furnish his or her social security number unless (a) the  
14 individual consents to provide or allow the use of his or her social  
15 security number, (b) the social security number is expressly required by  
16 federal, state, or local law, rule, regulation, or ordinance, or (c) the  
17 social security number is used for a criminal history background check of  
18 the individual by an employer or volunteer service organization.
