- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-6,356, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to the operation of utility-type vehicles; and
- 4 to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 60-6,356, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,356 (1) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle shall
- 4 not be operated on any controlled-access highway with more than two
- 5 marked traffic lanes. The , and the crossing of any controlled-access
- 6 highway with more than two marked traffic lanes shall not be permitted
- 7 except as provided in subsection (9) of this section. Subsections (2),
- 8 (3), and (5) through (8) of this section authorize and apply to operation
- 9 of an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle only on a highway
- 10 other than a controlled-access highway with more than two marked traffic
- 11 lanes.
- 12 (2) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle may be operated
- 13 in accordance with the operating requirements of subsection (3) of this
- 14 section:
- 15 (a) Outside the corporate limits of a city, village, or
- 16 unincorporated village if incidental to the vehicle's use for
- 17 agricultural purposes;
- 18 (b) Within the corporate limits of a city or village if authorized
- 19 by the city or village by ordinance adopted in accordance with this
- 20 section; or
- 21 (c) Within an unincorporated village if authorized by the county
- 22 board of the county in which the unincorporated village is located by
- 23 resolution in accordance with this section.
- 24 (3) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle may be operated
- 25 as authorized in subsection (2) of this section when such operation
- 26 occurs only between the hours of sunrise and sunset. Any person operating
- 27 an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle as authorized in
- 28 subsection (2) of this section shall have a valid Class O operator's
- 29 license or a farm permit as provided in section 60-4,126, shall have
- 30 liability insurance coverage for the all-terrain vehicle or a utility-
- 31 type vehicle while operating the all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type

- 1 vehicle on a highway, and shall not operate such vehicle at a speed in
- 2 excess of thirty miles per hour. The person operating the all-terrain
- 3 vehicle or a utility-type vehicle shall provide proof of such insurance
- 4 coverage to any peace officer requesting such proof within five days of
- 5 such a request. When operating an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type
- 6 vehicle as authorized in subsection (2) of this section, the headlight
- 7 and taillight of the vehicle shall be on and the vehicle shall be
- 8 equipped with a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet
- 9 above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle. The bicycle safety
- 10 flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty
- 11 square inches and shall be day-glow in color.
- 12 (4) All-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles may be operated
- 13 without complying with subsection (3) of this section on highways in
- 14 parades which have been authorized by the State of Nebraska or any
- department, board, commission, or political subdivision of the state.
- 16 (5) The Subject to subsection (1) of this section, the crossing of a
- 17 highway other than a controlled-access highway with more than two marked
- 18 <u>traffic lanes</u> shall be permitted by an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-
- 19 type vehicle without complying with subsection (3) of this section only
- 20 if:
- 21 (a) The crossing is made at an angle of approximately ninety degrees
- 22 to the direction of the highway and at a place where no obstruction
- 23 prevents a quick and safe crossing;
- (b) The vehicle is brought to a complete stop before crossing the
- 25 shoulder or roadway of the highway;
- 26 (c) The operator yields the right-of-way to all oncoming traffic
- 27 that constitutes an immediate potential hazard;
- 28 (d) In crossing a divided highway, the crossing is made only at an
- 29 intersection of such highway with another highway; and
- 30 (e) Both the headlight and taillight of the vehicle are on when the
- 31 crossing is made.

- 1 (6) All-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles may be operated
- 2 outside the corporate limits of any municipality by electric utility
- 3 personnel within the course of their employment in accordance with the
- 4 operation requirements of subsection (3) of this section, except that the
- 5 operation of the vehicle pursuant to this subsection need not be limited
- 6 to the hours between sunrise and sunset.
- 7 (7) A city or village may adopt an ordinance authorizing the
- 8 operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles within the
- 9 corporate limits of the city or village if the operation is in accordance
- 10 with subsection (3) of this section. The city or village may place other
- 11 restrictions on the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type
- 12 vehicles within its corporate limits.
- 13 (8) A county board may adopt a resolution authorizing the operation
- 14 of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles within any
- 15 unincorporated village within the county if the operation is in
- 16 accordance with subsection (3) of this section. The county may place
- 17 other restrictions on the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-
- 18 type vehicles within the unincorporated village.
- 19 (9) The crossing of a controlled-access highway with more than two
- 20 marked traffic lanes shall be permitted by a utility-type vehicle if the
- 21 operation is in accordance with the operation requirements of subsection
- 22 (3) of this section and if the following requirements are met:
- 23 (a) The crossing is made at an intersection that is controlled by a
- 24 <u>traffic control signal and is made in compliance with such traffic</u>
- 25 <u>control signal; and</u>
- 26 (b) The crossing at such intersection is specifically authorized as
- 27 <u>follows:</u>
- 28 <u>(i) If such intersection is located within the corporate limits of a</u>
- 29 <u>city or village, by ordinance of such city or village;</u>
- 30 <u>(ii) If such intersection is located within an unincorporated</u>
- 31 village, by resolution of the county board of the county in which such

- 1 <u>unincorporated village is located; or</u>
- 2 (iii) If such intersection is located outside the corporate limits
- 3 of a city or village and outside any unincorporated village, by
- 4 <u>resolution of the county board of the county in which such intersection</u>
- 5 <u>is located.</u>
- 6 Sec. 2. Original section 60-6,356, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is repealed.
