2	Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to repeal the Black-Tailed
3	Prairie Dog Management Act; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the
4	original section; and to outright repeal sections 23-3801, 23-3802,
5	23-3803, 23-3804, 23-3805, 23-3806, 23-3807, 23-3808, 23-3809, and
6	23-3810, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
7	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-2,236, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
 is amended to read:

3 81-2,236 The Director of Agriculture may contract and cooperate with the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service of the United States 4 5 Department of Agriculture in the management and control of (1) coyotes, bobcats, foxes, and other predatory animals listed in section 23-358 in 6 7 this state that are injurious to livestock, poultry, and game animals and the public health, (2) black-tailed prairie dogs and other injurious 8 9 commensal and field rodents, and (3) nuisance birds or other nuisance wildlife in accordance with organized and systematic plans of the Animal 10 and Plant Health Inspection Service of the United States Department of 11 Agriculture for the management and control of such animals. Supervision 12 of the program shall be by the local representative of the Animal and 13 14 Plant Health Inspection Service of the United States Department of Agriculture. Expenditure of funds appropriated by the Legislature may not 15 16 be made without the approval in writing by the director. The director in cooperation with the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service of the 17 United States Department of Agriculture may enter into agreements with 18 19 governmental agencies and with counties, other associations, corporations, or individuals when such cooperation is deemed to be 20 necessary to promote the management and control of such predatory 21 animals, black-tailed prairie dogs and other injurious commensal and 22 field rodents, nuisance birds, or other nuisance wildlife. 23
