## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 132**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Joint Public Agency Act; to amend
- 2 section 13-2530, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the
- 3 power of and procedures for joint public agencies to issue bonds as
- 4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 13-2530, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 13-2530 (1) Any joint public agency may issue such types of bonds as its board may determine subject only to any agreement with the holders of 4 5 outstanding bonds, including bonds as to which the principal and interest are payable exclusively from all or a portion of the revenue from one or 6 7 more projects, from one or more revenue-producing contracts, including securities acquired from any person, bonds issued by any qualified public 8 9 agency under the Public Facilities Construction and Finance Act, or 10 leases made by the joint public agency with any person, including any of the public agencies which are parties to the agreement creating the joint 11 public agency, or from its revenue generally or which may be additionally 12 secured by a pledge of any grant, subsidy, or contribution from any 13 person or a pledge of any income or revenue, funds, or money of the joint 14 public agency from any source whatsoever or a mortgage or security 15 16 interest in any real or personal property, commodity, product, or service 17 or interest therein.

(2) Any bonds issued by such joint public agency shall be issued on 18 behalf of the joint public agency solely for the specific purpose or 19 purposes for which the joint public agency has been created. Such 20 specific purposes may include, but shall not be limited to, joint 21 projects authorized by the Public Facilities Construction and Finance 22 Act; solid waste collection, management, and disposal; waste recycling; 23 24 sanitary sewage treatment and disposal; public safety communications; 25 correctional facilities; water treatment plants and distribution systems; drainage systems; flood control projects; fire protection services; 26 ground water quality management and control; river-flow enhancement; 27 28 education and postsecondary education; hospital and other health care services; bridges, roads, and streets; and law enforcement. 29

(3) If a joint public agency has powers of taxation under section 13-2507, the joint public agency shall issue bonds by following the bond

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- 1 issuance procedures required by law for the participating public agency
- 2 <u>from which the joint public agency derives the powers of taxation.</u>
- 3 Whenever the bond issuance procedures required by law for the
- 4 participating public agency conflict with any provision of the Joint
- 5 Public Agency Act, the bond issuance procedures required by law for the
- 6 participating public agency shall prevail.
- 7 (4 3) As an alternative to issuing bonds for financing public safety
- 8 communication projects, any joint public agency may enter into a
- 9 financing agreement with the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority for
- 10 such purpose.
- 11  $(\underline{5} \ 4)$  Any joint public agency formed for purposes of providing or
- 12 assisting with the provision of public safety communications may enter
- 13 into an agreement with any other joint public agency relating to (a) the
- 14 operation, maintenance, or management of the property or facilities of
- 15 such joint public agency or (b) the operation, maintenance, or management
- 16 of the property or facilities of such other joint public agency.
