- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to docket fees; to provide a docket fee for a
- 2 paternity determination or parental support proceeding.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) A docket fee of sixty-five dollars shall be 2 collected by the clerk of the county court or the clerk of the district 3 court for each paternity determination or parental support proceeding 4 under sections 43-1401 to 43-1418 or any modification of such proceeding 5 including a modification of an award of child support, child custody, or parenting time, visitation, or other access as defined in section 6 7 43-2922. Such fees shall be remitted to the State Treasurer on forms 8 prescribed by the State Treasurer within ten days after the close of each 9 month. Fifteen dollars shall be credited to the Legal Aid and Services 10 Fund, and fifty dollars shall be credited to the Parenting Act Fund. 11 (2) Any proceeding filed by a county attorney or an authorized 12 attorney as defined in section 43-1704 in a case in which services are 13 being provided under Title IV-D of the federal Social Security Act, as 14 amended, shall not be subject to this section.
