Section 1. Section 79-1125.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

2 is amended to read:

3 79-1125.01 Support services means preventive services for those 4 children from birth to age twenty-one years and, if the child's twentyfirst birthday occurs during the school year, until the end of that 5 school year, not identified or verified as children with disabilities 6 pursuant to sections 79-1118.01, 79-1138, and 79-1139 but demonstrating a 7 need for specially designed assistance in order to benefit from the 8 9 school district's general education curriculum and to avoid the need for potentially expensive special education placement and services. Support 10 services include the educational services provided to a child pursuant to 11 subdivision (10)(c) of section 79-215 by an interim-program school or an 12 13 approved or accredited school maintained by a residential setting if such child has not been identified or verified as a child with a disability 14 pursuant to sections 79-1118.01 and 79-1138 but demonstrates a need for 15 16 specially designed assistance by residing in a residential setting 17 described in subdivision (10)(a) of section 79-215. Support services may also include access to mental health services offered either at the 18 school or elsewhere, including, but not limited to, assessments, family 19 education services, and programs designated by the Division of Behavioral 20 Health of the Department of Health and Human Services. 21
