- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to eminent domain; to amend sections 57-1101
- 2 and 57-1408, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to
- 3 eliminate the power of eminent domain for certain pipelines; to
- 4 harmonize provisions; to repeal the original sections; and to
- 5 declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 57-1101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 57-1101 Any person engaged in, and any company, corporation, or
- 4 association formed or created for the purpose of, transporting or
- 5 conveying crude oil, petroleum, gases, or other products thereof in
- 6 interstate commerce through or across the State of Nebraska or intrastate
- 7 within the State of Nebraska, and desiring or requiring a right-of-way or
- 8 other interest in real estate and being unable to agree with the owner or
- 9 lessee of any land, lot, right-of-way, or other property for the amount
- 10 of compensation for the use and occupancy of so much of any lot, land,
- 11 real estate, right-of-way, or other property as may be reasonably
- 12 necessary for the laying, relaying, operation, and maintenance of any
- 13 such pipeline or the location of any plant or equipment necessary to
- 14 operate such pipeline, shall have the right to acquire the same for such
- 15 purpose through the exercise of the power of eminent domain, except that
- 16 <u>a for any</u> major oil pipeline as defined in section 57-1404 <u>shall not have</u>
- 17 to be placed in operation in the State of Nebraska after November 23,
- 18 2011, any such person, company, corporation, or association shall comply
- 19 with section 57-1503 and receive the approval of the Governor for the
- 20 route of the pipeline under such section or shall apply for and receive
- 21 an order approving the application under the Major Oil Pipeline Siting
- 22 Act, prior to having the rights provided under this section. If
- 23 condemnation procedures have not been commenced within two years after
- 24 the date the Governor's approval is granted or after the date of receipt
- 25 of an order approving an application under the Major Oil Pipeline Siting
- 26 Act, the right under this section expires. The procedure to condemn
- 27 property shall be exercised in the manner set forth in sections 76-704 to
- 28 76-724.
- 29 Sec. 2. Section 57-1408, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 30 2014, is amended to read:
- 31 57-1408 (1) Within seven months after the receipt of the application

- 1 under section 57-1405, the commission shall enter an order approving the
- 2 application or denying the application. The commission shall include in
- 3 the order the findings of the commission regarding the application and
- 4 the reasons for approving or denying the application. The order approving
- 5 the application shall state that the application is in the public
- 6 interest and shall authorize the pipeline carrier to act under section
- 7 <del>57-1101.</del>
- 8 (2) The commission may, for just cause, extend the time for the
- 9 entry of an order under subsection (1) of this section. The extension
- 10 shall not exceed twelve months after the receipt of the application under
- 11 section 57-1405 unless all parties agree to a longer extension, except
- 12 that no extension shall extend more than eight months after the issuance
- 13 of a presidential permit authorizing the construction of the major oil
- 14 pipeline.
- 15 (3) If the commission approves the application, the pipeline carrier
- 16 shall file a status report with the commission regarding the construction
- 17 of the major oil pipeline every six months until the completion of the
- 18 major oil pipeline within Nebraska. The pipeline carrier shall notify the
- 19 commission of the completion of the major oil pipeline within Nebraska
- 20 within thirty days after such completion.
- 21 (4) If the commission denies the application, the pipeline carrier
- 22 may amend the denied application in accordance with the findings of the
- 23 commission and submit the amended application within sixty days after the
- 24 issuance of the order denying the application. Within sixty days after
- 25 the receipt of the amended application, the commission shall enter an
- 26 order approving or denying the amended application after making new
- 27 findings under subsection (4) of section 57-1407.
- 28 Sec. 3. Original sections 57-1101 and 57-1408, Revised Statutes
- 29 Cumulative Supplement, 2014, are repealed.
- 30 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 31 passed and approved according to law.
