- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Tax Equity and Educational
- 2 Opportunities Support Act; to amend sections 79-1001 and 79-1022,
- 3 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for distribution of
- 4 certain funds as described; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the
- original sections; and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-1001, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-1001 Sections 79-1001 to 79-1033 <u>and section 2 of this act</u>shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities
- 5 Support Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. An amount of funds equal to the difference between the
- 7 total amount of state aid appropriated for school fiscal year 2013-14 and
- 8 the total amount of state aid appropriated for school fiscal year 2014-15
- 9 shall be distributed in school fiscal year 2015-16 to school districts
- 10 which did not receive equalization aid in school fiscal year 2014-15.
- 11 Such funds shall be distributed to such districts proportionally based on
- 12 <u>the number of students in each such district and shall be used only for</u>
- 13 property tax reduction.
- 14 Sec. 3. Section 79-1022, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 15 amended to read:
- 16 79-1022 (1)(a) On or before April 10, 2014, and on or before March 1
- 17 of each year thereafter for each ensuing fiscal year, the department
- 18 shall determine the amounts to be distributed to each local system and
- 19 each district for the ensuing school fiscal year pursuant to the Tax
- 20 Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act and shall certify the
- 21 amounts to the Director of Administrative Services, the Auditor of Public
- 22 Accounts, each learning community, and each district. The amount to be
- 23 distributed to each district that is not a member of a learning community
- 24 from the amount certified for a local system shall be proportional based
- 25 on the formula students attributed to each district in the local system.
- 26 The amount to be distributed to each district that is a member of a
- 27 learning community from the amount certified for the local system shall
- 28 be proportional based on the formula needs calculated for each district
- 29 in the local system. On or before April 10, 2014, and on or before March
- 30 1 of each year thereafter for each ensuing fiscal year, the department
- 31 shall report the necessary funding level for the ensuing school fiscal

- 1 year to the Governor, the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature,
- 2 and the Education Committee of the Legislature. The report submitted to
- 3 the committees of the Legislature shall be submitted electronically.
- 4 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, certified state aid
- 5 amounts, including adjustments pursuant to section 79-1065.02, shall be
- 6 shown as budgeted non-property-tax receipts and deducted prior to
- 7 calculating the property tax request in the district's general fund
- 8 budget statement as provided to the Auditor of Public Accounts pursuant
- 9 to section 79-1024.
- 10 (b) On or before July 1, 2015, the department shall determine the
- 11 <u>amount to be distributed pursuant to section 2 of this act to each</u>
- 12 <u>district eligible to receive funds pursuant to such section and shall</u>
- 13 <u>certify such amount to the Director of Administrative Services, the</u>
- 14 Auditor of Public Accounts, and each such district. Such funds shall be
- 15 distributed pursuant to subsection (2) of this section.
- 16 (2) Except as provided in this subsection, subsection (8) of section
- 17 79-1016, and sections 79-1033 and 79-1065.02, the amounts certified
- 18 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed in ten as
- 19 nearly as possible equal payments on the last business day of each month
- 20 beginning in September of each ensuing school fiscal year and ending in
- 21 June of the following year, except that when a school district is to
- 22 receive a monthly payment of less than one thousand dollars, such payment
- 23 shall be one lump-sum payment on the last business day of December during
- 24 the ensuing school fiscal year.
- 25 Sec. 4. Original sections 79-1001 and 79-1022, Reissue Revised
- 26 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 27 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 28 passed and approved according to law.
