A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Department of Natural Resources; to
 amend sections 61-201 and 61-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to director qualifications
 and employment of personnel; and to repeal the original sections.
 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 61-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

61-201 The Director of Natural Resources shall be qualified by 3 training and business experience to manage and supervise the Department 4 5 of Natural Resources. The director shall be a professional engineer as provided in the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act and have had at 6 7 least five years' experience in a position of responsibility in water resources management and irrigation work and either (1) be a professional 8 9 engineer under the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act or (2) have a doctorate degree in civil or hydraulic engineering, hydrology, or 10 geology. 11

12 Sec. 2. Section 61-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 13 amended to read:

61-202 The Director of Natural Resources may employ such personnel,
 including <u>a professional engineer under the Engineers and Architects</u>
 <u>Regulation Act and</u> legal and technical advisors, as necessary to carry
 out the duties required of the director.

Sec. 3. Original sections 61-201 and 61-202, Reissue Revised
Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
