1 Section 1. Section 79-544, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 79-544 (1) No member of a school board shall be engaged in a
- 4 contract to teach pursuant to sections 79-817 to 79-821 or be employed in
- 5 <u>any other capacity</u> with the school district which he or she serves as a
- 6 board member.
- 7 (2) No immediate family member of a school board member shall be
- 8 employed by the school district during the time in which the school board
- 9 member serves on such board. For purposes of this subsection, immediate
- 10 family member means the school board member's spouse, children, parents,
- 11 <u>stepchildren</u>, and stepparents.
- 12 Sec. 2. Original section 79-544, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, is repealed.
