A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to veterans; to amend section 80-413, Reissue
 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for retrocession of
 jurisdiction for land on which the Omaha National Cemetery is
 located; and to repeal the original section.
 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 80-413, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 80-413 (1) The consent of the State of Nebraska is hereby given to 4 the retrocession of jurisdiction, either partially or wholly, by the 5 Veterans' Administration, an agency of the United States Government, over 6 land owned by the United States within the boundaries of Nebraska, and 7 the Governor of the state is hereby authorized to accept for the state 8 such retrocession of jurisdiction.

9 (2) Retrocession of jurisdiction shall be effected upon written 10 notice to the Governor by the principal officer of the Veterans' 11 Administration having supervision and control over the land.

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(3) This section shall apply only to the following lands:

13 (a) Land on which is located the Veterans' Administration Hospital,
14 Omaha, Nebraska;

(b) Land on which is located the Veterans' Administration Hospital,
Lincoln, Nebraska;

17 (c) Land on which is located the Veterans' Administration Hospital,
18 Grand Island, Nebraska; and

(d) Land on which is located the Fort McPherson National Cemetery,
Maxwell, Nebraska; and -

(e) Land on which is located the Omaha National Cemetery, Sarpy
 County, Nebraska.

Sec. 2. Original section 80-413, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is repealed.

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
