- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public meetings; to amend section 84-1413,
- 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to authorize electronic voting
- devices for public bodies; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 84-1413, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-1413 (1) Each public body shall keep minutes of all meetings
- 4 showing the time, place, members present and absent, and the substance of
- 5 all matters discussed.
- 6 (2) Any action taken on any question or motion duly moved and
- 7 seconded shall be by roll call vote of the public body in open session,
- 8 and the record shall state how each member voted or if the member was
- 9 absent or not voting. The requirements of a roll call or viva voce vote
- 10 shall be satisfied by a public body municipality, a county, a learning
- 11 community, a joint entity created pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation
- 12 Act, a joint public agency created pursuant to the Joint Public Agency
- 13 Act, or an agency formed under the Municipal Cooperative Financing Act
- 14 which utilizes an electronic voting device which allows the yeas and nays
- of each member of such public city council, village board, county board,
- 16 or governing body to be readily seen by the public.
- 17 (3) The vote to elect leadership within a public body may be taken
- 18 by secret ballot, but the total number of votes for each candidate shall
- 19 be recorded in the minutes.
- 20 (4) The minutes of all meetings and evidence and documentation
- 21 received or disclosed in open session shall be public records and open to
- 22 public inspection during normal business hours.
- 23 (5) Minutes shall be written, except as provided in subsection (6)
- 24 of this section, and available for inspection within ten working days or
- 25 prior to the next convened meeting, whichever occurs earlier, except that
- 26 cities of the second class and villages may have an additional ten
- 27 working days if the employee responsible for writing the minutes is
- 28 absent due to a serious illness or emergency.
- 29 (6) Minutes of the meetings of the board of a school district or
- 30 educational service unit may be kept as an electronic record.
